

## Saint George's School 2009-2010 Admissions Checklist

- Schedule a Saint George's School tour. Families are welcome to visit, at their convenience, Monday through Thursday, 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM. Please schedule this visit with the Admission Office, 509.466.1636, extension 304. Friday or weekend tours available upon request.

- Complete the application and transcript request form and mail to Saint George's School.

***For timely consideration, please submit all application materials by March 2, 2009.***

*Note: Kindergarten students must be 5 years old by September 1 of the entry year.*

- Include the \$50 application fee.
- Complete the Academic References portion of the application. Only one reference is necessary for kindergarten and first grade applicants. All Applicants for Grades kindergarten -twelve must include the current classroom/homeroom teacher.
- High School applicants as well as eighth-grade applicants** must include the names of their current Math and History or English teachers on the Academic References portion of the application.
- All applications** must include a copy of the applicant's current progress report or grades.
- Applicants first through twelfth-grade must also include a copy of end-of-year progress report or grades from June 2008.
- Submit a copy of any standardized test scores when applicable.

- Upper and Middle School applicants are encouraged to join us for a Saint George's School Preview Day. Upper School – January 14 or 15; Middle School, February 24. Please call to register.
- Applicants for Middle or Upper School must complete placement testing.** Testing will be held January 14 and 15, 1:00 p.m. and Saturday, March 21, 2009, 9:00 a.m. as well as by appointment. Out of state tests may be proctored. ISEE, PSAT, SAT scores also accepted.
