GLOBAL REPRESENTATION

Saint George's current and recent students have come from many countries including Bosnia, China, France, Germany, Japan, Norway, Romania, Russia, South Korea, Spain, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, and Vietnam. Approximately 18% of our students in grades 8-12 are international students. We also employ faculty and staff with extensive international experience.

SPOKANE COMMUNITY

- **LOCATION:** Spokane is located on the scenic Spokane River in eastern Washington state. Its international airport is a short one-hour flight from such world-class cities as Seattle, Portland, and Vancouver, British Columbia. (Spokane's airport code is GEG.)
- **POPULATION:** Spokane is the second largest city in Washington state. With a metro area population of over half a million, it is the largest city between Seattle and Minneapolis.
- **CLIMATE:** Spokane enjoys a four-seasons climate. The region is considered high desert, receiving 260 days of sunshine and just 17 inches (43 cm.) of precipitation per year.
- **RESOURCES:** The Spokane region serves as the business, transportation, medical, industrial and cultural hub of the Inland Northwest, an area that includes more than 1.4 million people. Spokane is home to two private universities (Gonzaga University and Whitworth University) and two public universities (Eastern Washington University and Washington State University). Spokane is particularly known for medical services and education, with six major hospitals, colleges of nursing and pharmacy, and a recently created medical school.



SGS students earn state championships and travel to national and international competitions.



- **ATTRACTIONS:** Surrounded by mountains, forests and 76 lakes, Spokane offers endless water sports, numerous golf courses, and five major ski areas within a two-hour drive. Its active downtown features numerous art galleries, world-class museums, shopping venues, and a variety of musical and dramatic performances.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

- Saint George's is an International Baccalaureate World School, offering the Diploma Programme for grades 11-12. The IB is a rigorous liberal arts curriculum that prepares students for success in higher education and life in a global society. An IB Diploma significantly increases acceptance rates at top tier universities across the U.S., and it has gained recognition and respect from the world's leading universities.
