Tent with only 1 person per tent (may borrow from the Outdoor Club)

2 water bottles or a hydration system with day pack for your layers and gear

Raingear this includes rain jacket and pants

Warm shoes or boots to be out at night in

Synthetic or wool tops and bottom – No Cotton

Heavier weight Top and bottom for at night – Like a super warm winter coat!

Wool or Fleece hat and gloves

personal medication

personal toiletries

Headlamp or flashlight

Camera gear if you own it. Please talk to Maja at our lunch meeting about your gear to see if it will work for night photography or we will share gear.
